

2020 Online Rules Meeting CORRECTIONS

There are a few glitches with the Rules Meeting. Here you will find the correct voice over that goes with the appropriate slides.

SLIDE 2: No sound

- At the end of the meeting, there's an attendance verification form which you must complete.
- Coaches MAY NOT watch the rules meeting together on the same computer, since one coach's name may be on the verification form and only one verification form is available per rules meeting.
- If two or more coaches are now on the same computer, please stop and resume the rules meeting on individual computers.
- Also, be sure your computer is hooked up to a printer to print this verification form.

SLIDE 4: Lost sound

- It's important for coaches to remember that just watching the PowerPoint does not take the place of coaches knowing the rules.
- In fact, it's suggested that coaches have their team's choreographer watch this PowerPoint also.

- The main reason for following the National Federation Spirit Rules is for the safety of the cheerleaders.
- Equally important is the fact that following these rules is required in Iowa. Following the rules helps protect coaches and schools from liability issues, plus it's a coach's responsibility.

SLIDE 21: Incorrect Voice Over

- General Coaching Principles has information that's important for all coaches to know and follow.
- Three areas covered are Performance Surfaces, Concussions, and Professional Development.

SLIDE 25: Incorrect Voice Over

- In the state of Iowa, all High School cheer programs must follow the NFHS spirit rules but we also have Iowa strengthened rules.
- In the following section of this rules meeting, I will go over how to use the ICCA website with a particular focus on the rules.
